6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the qualifications of district
7 judges; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.15.160(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A district judge shall be a citizen of the United States and
11 of the state, at least 21 years of age, a resident of the state for at
12 least one year immediately preceding his appointment, and at the time
13 of his appointment licensed to practice law in the State of Alaska, or
14 have served as a district judge of this state for a continuous period
15 of eight years immediately preceding September 1, 1968. The supreme
16 court may prescribe additional qualifications.

17 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 1968.
