6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to liens for wages."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 34.35.435 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 34.35.435. LIEN FOR WAGES. When a clerk, accountant, book-
10 keeper, waiter, waitress, cook, maid, porter, servant, employee,
11 artisan, craftsman, factory operator, mill operator, mechanic, quarry-
12 man, common laborer, farm hand, labors or performs a service in an
13 office, store, hotel, rooming house, boarding house, restaurant, cafe,
14 shop, newspaper plant, factory, quarry, or mill, of any character, or
15 upon a farm, under or by virtue of a contract or agreement, written or
16 verbal, with a person or employer, or his agent, receiver or trustee,
17 in order to secure the payment of the amount due or owing under the
18 contract or agreement, written or verbal, the employee has a preferred
19 [FIRST] lien over all other lien holders including first mortgage
20 holders upon all products, machinery, tools, fixtures, appurtenances,
21 goods, wares, merchandise, chattels, wagons, carts, or things of value,
22 of whatsoever character, that are created in whole or in part by the
23 labor or that may be used or useful by the person or may be necessarily
24 connected with the performance of the labor or service, which may be
25 owned by the employer, or his agent, receiver, or trustee.
