6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to time that a person can serve as
7 a juror; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 09.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 09.20.025. LIMITATION ON JURY SERVICE. No person may be
11 required to serve more than three months as a juror during any
12 consecutive two-year period provided that if a person is serving as
13 a juror at the conclusion of the three months period, he shall complete
14 the trial then in progress.

15 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
16 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
