6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the reporting of treatment of,  
7 or consultation for treatment of, gunshot wounds."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 11.67 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 ARTICLE 2. REPORTS OF TREATMENT OF, OR CONSULTATION FOR  
11 TREATMENT OF, GUNSHOT WOUNDS.

12 Sec. 11.67.080. GUNSHOT WOUNDS TO BE REPORTED. A person who is  
13 consulted for the treatment of, or who treats, a gunshot wound shall  
14 make an oral report to the state police within 24 hours of the consulta-  
15 tion or the treatment of the wound. If the state police are not avail-  
16 able, an oral report shall be made to the nearest law enforcement  
17 authority within 24 hours of the consultation or the treatment of the  
18 wound. The report shall include the name and address of the person  
19 who suffered the wound, if known. A person who fails to file a report  
20 is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine  
21 of not more than \$500, or by imprisonment for not more than one year, or  
22 by both.
