6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to rewards for persons providing in-
7 formation leading to arrest and conviction of
8 narcotic peddlers."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 17.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 17.10.211. SALE TO MINORS. (a) A person providing informa-
12 tion which leads to the arrest and conviction of another on the charge
13 of unlawfully selling narcotic drugs to a minor is eligible for a
14 reward of \$5,000, if the person solicited to receive the drug is over
15 19 years of age but below 21 years of age at the time of the solicita-
16 tion. If the person solicited is under 19 years of age the person
17 providing this information is eligible for a reward of \$10,000.

18 (b) The district attorney in the judicial district where the
19 prosecution for the unlawful sale of the narcotic drug takes place
20 shall determine if the person requesting the reward is entitled to it
21 under this section. If the district attorney determines that the
22 person is eligible to receive the reward he shall promptly file a
23 certification to this effect with the Department of Public Safety.
24 Upon receiving certification the Department of Public Safety shall
25 pay the reward from appropriations made to that department for the
26 purpose of carrying out the provisions of this section.
