6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the establishment of on-the-job
7 training programs."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 36 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 30. ON-THE-JOB TRAINING.

11 Sec. 36.30.010. REQUIREMENT OF ON-THE-JOB TRAINING. In contracts
12 let by the state for work on public construction there shall be a
13 requirement that at least one on-the-job training program be provided
14 by the contractor for residents according to standards determined by
15 the Department of Labor.

16 Sec. 36.30.020. DUTIES OF THE DEPARTMENT. The number of on-the-
17 job training programs which must be furnished by the contractor under
18 each contract and the type and specifications of each program shall be
19 determined by the department.

20 Sec. 36.30.030. WAGE RATES FOR ON-THE-JOB TRAINEES. The contrac-
21 tor shall pay the on-the-job trainee at not less than the state minimum
22 wage rate.

23 Sec. 36.30.040. VIOLATION OF THIS CHAPTER. The Department of
24 Labor has the authority to determine whether or not secs. 10 - 30 of
25 this chapter are being violated. If a person violates secs. 10 - 30
26 of this chapter the attorney general shall, when instructed by the
27 department, take immediate steps to enforce these provisions.
