6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the issuance of drivers' licenses."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 Section 1. AS 28.15.030(2) is amended to read:

9 (2) who has not attained the age of 18 [16] years, except  
10 that the department may issue a restrictive operator's license to a  
11 person who is at least 14 years of age; the department may, however,  
12 issue a license to an applicant who has reached the age of 16, provided  
13 that the applicant shows proof that he has satisfactorily completed an  
14 approved course of driver instruction in either a public school or a  
15 licensed commercial driving school operating under ch. 17 of this title;
