6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to collective bargaining represent-  
7 ation for certain state employees."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 23.40.010 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 23.40.010. UNION CONTRACTS WITH STATE AND POLITICAL SUBDIVI-  
11 SIONS. (a) The state or a political subdivision of the state, includ-  
12 ing but not limited to an organized borough, municipal corporation,  
13 independent school district, incorporated school district, and public  
14 utility district, may enter into a contract with a labor organization  
15 whose members furnish services to the state or the political subdivision.

16 (b) Nothing contained in this chapter requires the state [OR  
17 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE] to enter into a union contract.

18 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, the  
19 University of Alaska and all state political subdivisions shall recog-  
20 nize an elected collective bargaining representative.

21 (d) The department shall set up procedures for election so that  
22 employees may select their collective bargaining representative and  
23 supervise the elections to prevent unfair labor practices. Before these  
24 elections the department shall, upon application, make a determination  
25 as to the appropriateness of the collective bargaining unit proposed in  
26 the application.

27 ~~(e) The elected collective bargaining representative is required~~  
28 ~~to submit an annual report and nothing in this chapter shall be~~  
29 ~~construed to allow a strike by the employees.~~
