6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the misbranding of halibut."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 17.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 17.20.045. MISBRANDING HALIBUT. No person may label or
10 offer for sale any food fish product designated as halibut, with or
11 without additional descriptive words, unless the food fish product is
12 Hippoglossus Hippoglossus or Hippoglossus Stenolepis. A person who
13 violates this section is guilty of the misbranding of food under the
14 provisions of this chapter.
