6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to persons who waste or destroy fish
7 and game in this state."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05.830 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.830. [WANTON] WASTE. It is unlawful for a person to
11 waste [WANTONLY] or destroy [UNNECESSARILY] fish or game taken or caught
12 in the waters or on the land of the state. However, this prohibition
13 does not apply to fish or game which the department, by regulation,
14 declares to be of a destructive, noxious or nuisance character.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 16.30.010 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 16.30.010. PENALTIES FOR [WANTON] DESTRUCTION OF WILD FOOD
17 ANIMAL OR FISH. A person who kills a wild food animal or fish and
18 fails to make a reasonable effort to utilize it for food, [OR WHO KILLS
19 A WILD FOOD ANIMAL WITH INTENT TO WANTONLY DESTROY IT,] is guilty of a
20 misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by fine of not more than
21 \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both.
