6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the intentional waste of fish,
7 bear and wild food animals; and providing for an
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 16.05.830 is repealed.

11 * Sec. 2. AS 16.30.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

12 CHAPTER 30. DESTRUCTION OF FISH AND WILD ANIMALS.

13 Sec. 16.30.010. WASTE OF FISH AND WILD ANIMALS. (a) A person
14 who intentionally kills a fish or wild food animal and does not make a
15 reasonable effort to salvage all of its edible meat for human consumption,
16 is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine
17 of not more than \$500, or by imprisonment for not more than six months,
18 or by both.

19 (b) A person's failure to salvage all of a wild food animal's
20 edible meat for human consumption due to any fact which the person knew
21 or should have known would make it unreasonably difficult or impossible
22 for him to salvage the portion of the animal required under this section
23 constitutes a violation of (a) of this section.

24 (c) The shooting of a wild food animal or bear is prima facie
25 evidence of intent to kill it.

26 * Sec. 3. AS 16.30 is amended by adding new sections to read:

27 Sec. 16.30.020. FISH AND ANIMALS EXCEPTED. The provisions of
28 sec. 10 of this chapter do not apply to fish or animals which the
29 department declares by regulation to be of a destructive, noxious, or

1 nuisance character.

2 Sec. 16.30.030. DEFINITIONS. As used in this chapter

3 (1) "wild food animal" includes a moose, caribou, mountain
4 sheep, mountain goat, reindeer, deer, elk, bison, muskox, duck, geese,
5 brant, Wilson or jack snipe, grouse and ptarmigan;

6 (2) "department" means the Department of Fish and Game.

7 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
8 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
