6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to professional and occupational
7 licensing examinations."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.01.050(2) is amended to read:

10 (2) maintain records and files, including a file of the
11 questions on each examination and the model answers used in grading
12 each examination;

13 * Sec. 2. AS 08.01.050(8) is amended to read:

14 (8) notify applicants of results of examinations, specifying
15 the score on each question;

16 * Sec. 3. AS 08.01.050 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

17 (19) retain each applicant's examination papers after notify-
18 ing him of his score;

19 (20) upon his request, furnish an examinee whose application
20 was rejected a copy of his examination papers, the examination questions
21 and the model answers used in grading the examination.

22 * Sec. 4. AS 08.01.070(3) is amended to read:

23 (3) hold at least one examination each year, and, where an
24 oral examination is authorized, provide a written examination in lieu
25 of the oral one for an applicant who requests this substitution;

26 * Sec. 5. AS 08.01.070(8) is amended to read:

27 (8) forward [RESULTS OF EXAMINATIONS] to the department
28 within 20 days after grading is completed the results of an examination,
29 the examination questions, each examinee's examination papers and the

■ Sec. 6. AS 08.08 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 08.08.205. EXAMINATION RESULTS AND PAPERS. As soon as practicable after the examination papers have been graded, but within 30 days of the examination, the board shall send to each examinee a report showing his numerical score on each question and an acceptance or rejection of his application. An examinee whose application has been rejected on the grounds that he did not pass the examination shall be furnished, upon his request, a copy of his examination papers, the examination questions and the model answers used in grading the examination.

■ Sec. 7. AS 21.27.080(a) is amended to read:

(a) The answers of the applicant to an examination shall be written by the applicant under the director's supervision, and the written examination may be supplemented by oral examination at the director's discretion. However, when he decides that a supplementary examination is desirable the director shall provide a written one in lieu of the oral one for an applicant who requests this substitution.

■ Sec. 8. AS 21.27.080 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(e) As soon as practicable after the examination papers have been graded, but within 30 days of the examination, the board shall send to each examinee a report showing his numerical score on each question and an acceptance or rejection of his application. An examinee whose application has been rejected on the grounds that he did not pass the examination shall be furnished, upon his request, a copy of his examination papers, the examination questions and the model answers used in grading the examination.
