6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Statute of Limitations for
7 filing wage complaints; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 23.10.130 (b) is amended to read:

11 (b) For the purposes of this section, an action is considered
12 to be started on the date when the complaint is filed either in a
13 court of competent jurisdiction or with the Department of Labor. If it
14 is a collective or class action under sec. 110 of this chapter, it is
15 considered to be started as to an individual claimant on the date when
16 the complaint is filed if he is specifically named as a party plaintiff
17 or, if not named on the date of filing, on the subsequent date on which
18 his name is added as a party plaintiff.

19 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
20 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
