6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Social Security Amendments  
7 of 1967; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 23.15 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 ARTICLE 5. WORK INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR WELFARE RECIPIENTS.

11 Sec. 23.15.650. PARTICIPATION IN WORK INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR  
12 WELFARE RECIPIENTS. In order to provide those receiving aid to  
13 families with dependent children with incentives, opportunities, and  
14 necessary services for employment, training and participation in the  
15 regular economy the Department of Labor is authorized to administer  
16 the Work Incentive Program for Welfare Recipients. This authorization  
17 includes authority to execute on behalf of the state agreements or  
18 contracts with the appropriate federal agencies containing provisions  
19 which may be necessary or desirable to enable the state to participate  
20 in the program to receive and expend all appropriate funds made avail-  
21 able for the program by the state or by the federal government, to  
22 supervise the expenditures of the funds and the conduct of the program,  
23 and to make reports and certificates which are called for, and other-  
24 wise to cooperate with the federal government and its departments and  
25 agencies in the administration of the program.
