6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the service of administrative
7 summons; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 43.05.040(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) A summons may be served by the commissioner of public safety
11 or a peace officer designated by him or by a person designated by the
12 Department of Revenue, by personally delivering an attested copy to the
13 person to whom it is directed, or by leaving it at his last and usual
14 place of abode. The certificate of service signed by the person serving
15 the summons shall be evidence of the facts it states on the hearing of
16 an application for the enforcement of the summons. If a person who is
17 summoned neglects or refuses to obey the summons issued as provided in
18 this section, the department may report the fact to the superior court
19 of the judicial district within which the person so summoned resides or
20 or is found. The [AND THE] court may compel obedience to the summons
21 to the same extent as witnesses may be compelled to obey the subpoenas
22 of the court.

23 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
24 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
