For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the service of administrative
summons; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 43.05.040(b) is amended to read:

10

(b) A summons may be served by the commissioner of public safety
or a peace officer designated by him or by a person designated by the
Department of Revenue, by delivering a copy to the person to whom it is
directed, in a manner allowed under the Rules of Civil Procedure for the
service of a summons. The certificate of service signed by the person
serving the summons shall be evidence of the facts it states on the
hearing of an application for the enforcement of the summons. If a
person who is summoned neglects or refuses to obey the summons issued as
provided in this section, the department may report the fact to the
superior court of the judicial district within which the person so
summoned resides or is found. The [AND THE] court may compel obedience
to the summons to the same extent as witnesses may be compelled to obey
the subpoenas of the court.
