6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to carrier permits; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 42.10.220 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 42.10.220. TRANSFER OF PERMITS. (a) No permit issued under
11 this chapter may be transferred without prior approval of the commissioner
12 [IS IRREVOCABLE. A PERMIT MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED OR ASSIGNED EXCEPT
13 UPON A SHOWING THAT PROPERTY RIGHTS MAY BE AFFECTED]. The transfer
14 [OR ASSIGNMENT] of a permit is in the discretion of the commission.
15 The fee for the transfer [OR ASSIGNMENT] of a permit is \$50 [\$25].

16 (b) A carrier who ceases operation or [AND] abandons his rights
17 under a permit shall notify the commission in writing within 30 days
18 of cessation or abandonment.

19 (c) When a carrier has ceased operation or abandoned his rights
20 under a permit, the commission shall immediately suspend the authority
21 contained in the permit for a period of 180 days. Should the carrier
22 fail to reinstitute service within the 180-day period, the commission
23 may institute action for revocation of the permit.

24 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
25 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
