6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to eligibility for parole of persons
7 serving life sentences."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 33.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 33.15.185. ELIGIBILITY FOR PAROLE OF PERSON SERVING LIFE
11 SENTENCE. In determining eligibility for the parole of a person serving
12 a life sentence, the board shall consider a life sentence to be the
13 number of years remaining in a person's life from the date of sentencing
14 based on actuarial tables. However, in no case is a person sentenced
15 to life imprisonment eligible for parole until he has served at least
16 15 years.
