6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to sabbatical leave for teachers."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 14.20.280 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 14.20.280. BASIS OF LEAVE. A teacher who has rendered active
10 service for seven or more years in a district is eligible for [ENTITLED
11 TO] sabbatical leave. Sabbatical leave may be taken for educational
12 purposes only, and for not more than one school year.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 14.20.310(a) is amended to read:

14 (a) The number of teachers eligible for [ENTITLED TO] sabbatical
15 leave which may be allowed under secs. 280 - 350 of this chapter is as
16 follows:

17 (1) not more than one-half of one per cent of the total
18 number of teachers from all borough and city school districts and the
19 state-operated school district may be on state-supported sabbatical
20 leave in any year;

21 (2) any number of teachers may be on sabbatical leave at
22 school district or personal expense.
