6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to participation in programs of
7 manpower training by the Department of Labor; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 23.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 23.15.620. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR PARTICIPATION IN MANPOWER
12 TRAINING PROGRAMS. (a) The Department of Labor is authorized to
13 participate in programs of manpower training if it finds they are
14 necessary to meet the occupational needs of the state. This
15 authorization includes authority to execute on behalf of the state
16 agreements or contracts which may be necessary or desirable to enable
17 the state to participate in a program, to receive and expend all
18 appropriate funds made available for programs by the state or from
19 other sources, to supervise the expenditure of the funds and conduct
20 of the programs by other public and private agencies of the state, and
21 to make the reports and certificates which are called for, and in
22 cooperative arrangements with the Department of Education.

23 (b) The Department of Labor shall expend funds solely for the
24 payment of transportation, subsistence and training allowances to
25 trainees and for necessary administrative costs of the department in
26 carrying out the program. The allowance payments to trainees will be
27 paid in accordance with guidelines provided by the U. S. Manpower
28 Development and Training Act of 1962 as amended, and by regulations
29 promulgated by the Department of Labor.

(c) The Department of Education shall work in cooperation with the Department of Labor and shall provide training facilities and training instructors as needed for the programs with funds made available to the Department of Education for such purposes.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
