6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for a disaster relief fund in the
7 Office of the Governor; and providing for an
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 44.19 is amended by adding new sections to read:

11 ARTICLE 3A. DISASTER RELIEF FUND.

12 Sec. 44.19.171. DISASTER RELIEF FUND. (a) There is in the
13 Office of the Governor a disaster relief fund. The Department of
14 Revenue is custodian of the fund.

15 (b) Subject to the restrictions of (c) and (d) of this section,
16 the governor may, without additional legislative authorization,
17 expend not more than \$500,000 of the assets of the disaster relief
18 fund for the following purposes:

19 (1) to implement provisions of law relating to natural
20 disaster relief in the case of a natural disaster as defined in
21 sec. 175 occurring after the effective date of this Act;

22 (2) to alleviate the effects of a natural disaster as
23 defined in sec. 175 occurring after the effective date of this Act;

24 (3) to prevent or minimize the effects of an event which
25 occurs in any part of the state after the effective date of this
26 Act and which, in the determination of the governor, poses a direct
27 and imminent threat of resulting in a natural disaster of sufficient
28 magnitude and severity to justify state action.

29 (c) Expenditures authorized by the legislature to alleviate

1 effects of the natural disaster occurring on August 14, 1967 shall be
2 reimbursed to the general fund from the disaster relief fund before
3 any other expenditures may be made from the disaster relief fund.

4 (d) The governor shall present to the legislature an annual
5 accounting of money expended from the disaster relief fund.

6 Sec. 44.19.173. LIMIT ON APPROPRIATIONS. Funds appropriated by
7 the legislature to the disaster relief fund in any one fiscal year
8 shall not exceed the amount of money collected in the preceding fiscal
9 year from the disaster relief tax levied under AS 43.43. However,
10 money authorized for the fund from other public or private sources
11 shall be accepted and deposited in the fund.

12 Sec. 44.19.175. DEFINITION. In sec. 171(b)(1) and (2) of this
13 chapter "natural disaster" means a flood, fire, drought, earthquake,
14 tidal wave, typhoon, storm or other natural disaster occurring in any
15 part of the state after the effective date of this Act and declared by
16 the President of the United States to be a major disaster under the
17 provisions of the Federal Disaster Act of 1950, Title 42, United
18 States Code, secs. 1855-1855g.

19 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
20 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
