2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 9

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the need for facilities
6 for the disposal of human waste.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS this is the centennial of the purchase of Alaska; and

9 WHEREAS many people will be visiting Alaska in trailers and motor
10 homes; and

11 WHEREAS many Alaskan boroughs, cities, town and villages quite properly
12 prohibit the indiscriminate dumping of human waste from these self-contained
13 vehicles within their boundaries for aesthetic and health reasons; and

14 WHEREAS this prohibition without compensatory facilities for disposing
15 of the waste merely results in clandestine disposal;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that health agencies of the state, boroughs and munici-
17 palities be encouraged by all possible means to welcome visitors in trailers,
18 motor homes and similar vehicles by the immediate construction of clearly
19 marked and easily accessible comfort stations with water and toilet facil-
20 ities and public health approved measures for disposal of human waste.
