3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to a hearing and report

6 with regard to a state prison.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS there is no room or facilities for exercise or rehabilitation
9 in the present state jails; and

10 WHEREAS the present overall conditions in the state jails can be and
11 have been described as deplorable; and

12 WHEREAS these facts do harm to both the inmates and to society in
13 general; and

14 WHEREAS the state spends a great amount of money sending convicted
15 felons to other states for imprisonment;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to conduct a
17 state-wide hearing as to whether or not Alaska should have its own state
18 prison consisting of modern facilities, and to make a full report of its
19 findings to the Fifth Legislature, Second Session.
