5 Relating to a Fort Yukon access  
6 road feasibility study.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS there is presently no access road connecting Fort Yukon with  
9 the arterial highway system of the state; and

10 WHEREAS the building of an access road from Fort Yukon to the arterial  
11 highway system of the state would allow a large area of the state to be  
12 fully developed; and

13 WHEREAS potential tourism, mineral exploration, agricultural develop-  
14 ment demand it; and

15 WHEREAS access to the rest of the state is essential to residents of  
16 the Fort Yukon area and would benefit all of the state;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the governor is respectfully requested to direct  
18 the Department of Highways to conduct a feasibility study for an access  
19 road connecting Fort Yukon with the arterial highway system of the state,  
20 and to report its findings and recommendations to the Second Session of the  
21 Fifth Legislature.
