5 Welcoming The Honorable Heinrich  
6 Luebke, President of the Federal  
7 Republic of Germany, and his  
8 entourage to the State of Alaska.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS, The Honorable Heinrich Luebke, during a long and distinguished  
11 career in the service of the German people, has demonstrated his deep and  
12 active commitment to the cause of freedom and justice; and

13 WHEREAS, in recognition of such commitment and his manifold services  
14 to the Federal Republic of Germany during its formative years, The Honorable  
15 Heinrich Luebke has been elected and now serves as the President and Head of  
16 State of the said Federal Republic of Germany; and

17 WHEREAS, in the discharge of his official duties, and with the commend-  
18 able objective of furthering international understanding among peoples of  
19 diverse cultures and political, social, and economic systems, The Honorable  
20 Heinrich Luebke has undertaken an extensive and demanding journey to various  
21 nations on the Asian continent; and

22 WHEREAS, The Honorable Heinrich Luebke, while en route from his nation's  
23 capital city to Seoul, capital city of the Republic of Korea, on February 28,  
24 1967, will break his journey at Anchorage, largest city of the State of  
25 Alaska, and will remain therein for a period of one day; and

26 WHEREAS, the State of Alaska is the gateway of the United States of  
27 America to the vast continent of Asia, and the people of Alaska share in a  
28 very special way the concern of The Honorable Heinrich Luebke and his  
29 government that there be a mutually rewarding understanding among the

1 peoples of the West and East; and

2       **WHEREAS**, the State of Alaska is honored and privileged to have the  
3 opportunity to welcome through its Governor and other public officials and  
4 citizens The Honorable Heinrich Luebke, Mrs. Luebke, and the other official  
5 and nonofficial members of his entourage;

6       **BE IT RESOLVED** that the legislature of the State of Alaska on behalf  
7 of all the people of Alaska extends its welcome to The Honorable Heinrich  
8 Luebke, President of the Federal Republic of Germany, to his gracious wife,  
9 and to the several dignitaries, officials, representatives, and employees  
10 of his government and representatives of news media who accompany him,  
11 expresses its fervent hope that his mission will contribute to better under-  
12 standing among the peoples of the world and to the realization of peace  
13 with justice among the nations, and wishes him and those who accompany him  
14 "Gute Reise"; and be it

15       **FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this resolution, suitably enrolled, be  
16 presented to The Honorable Heinrich Luebke on behalf of the legislature by  
17 Representative William J. Moran, Honorary Consul of the Federal Republic of  
18 Germany for Alaska.
