5 Requesting early action regarding  
6 the planning for and construction of  
7 the Stikine River access road to  
8 Canada.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS access to the Continental United States from Southeastern  
11 Alaska by road has been a long-standing and long-recognized need; and

12 WHEREAS there have been two major studies of the highway and highway  
13 access problems of Alaska during the past 10 years, the report of the  
14 International Rail and Highway Commission and the "Highway Need Study Pro-  
15 gram"; and

16 WHEREAS both of these reports indicate the need for and feasibility of  
17 an access road up the valley of the Stikine River to connect with the  
18 Canadian road system;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to apply all  
20 the energy and facilities of his office to accomplish the necessary planning  
21 and other action for the early construction of the access road up the valley  
22 of the Stikine River in order that Southeastern Alaska can be connected with  
23 the highways leading to the Continental United States.
