5 **Relating to the building of a ferry**
6 **terminal in Kake, Alaska.**

7 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

8 **WHEREAS the Marine Highway was built to serve the communities of the**
9 **main portion of Southeastern Alaska; and**

10 **WHEREAS the Marine Highway mainly and currently is serving only the**
11 **larger towns and by-passes the smaller outlying communities of interest and**
12 **importance; and**

13 **WHEREAS Kake is one of these smaller communities which can offer**
14 **interesting points and can be served by the Marine Highway because of its**
15 **location near the direct route of the Petersburg and Sitka run with a mini-**
16 **um loss of time; and**

17 **WHEREAS an estimated fifty families will be moving into the Kake area**
18 **within a few months for logging operations which will tend to increase**
19 **airplane and ferry travel; and**

20 **WHEREAS there will exist a need for much heavy equipment and supplies**
21 **to be brought into Kake; and**

22 **WHEREAS a ferry stop-over at Kake had been discussed in the Southeast**
23 **Conference meetings of mayors and representatives of the Chambers of Com-**
24 **merce;**

25 **BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct**
26 **the Department of Public Works to build a ferry terminal at Kake, Alaska.**
