5 Requesting an Attorney General opinion
6 concerning Chapter 166, SLA 1966.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS it is of utmost importance to the citizens of Alaska that the
9 state's public bonding be maintained according to principle acceptable to
10 the citizenry; and

11 WHEREAS the State Legislature and executive branch of government must
12 scrutinize their own actions to maintain their public trust; and

13 WHEREAS the Legislature needs legal guidance in interpreting the word
14 "roads" used in the bonding proposal included in ch. 166, SLA 1966;

15 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct
16 the Attorney General to provide the Legislature with an opinion as to the
17 definition of "roads" as used in the bonding proposal; and be it

18 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Attorney General give an opinion as to the
19 definition of "roads which are not eligible for designation or have not
20 been designated as part of the Federal Aid Highway System" as used in the
21 bonding proposal, and report his findings to the Fifth Legislature, First
22 Session.
