6 Fish Hook - Willow road.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the Fish Hook - Willow road goes through an important agri-
9 cultural area; and

10 WHEREAS the Fish Hook - Willow road leads into the Hatcher Pass area,
11 one of the most scenic in the state; and

12 WHEREAS the Fish Hook - Willow road leads into a major hard-rock mining
13 area; and

14 WHEREAS the Fish Hook - Willow road leads into a major skiing area
15 which is important to tourism; and

16 WHEREAS this road is badly in need of paving and upgrading;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct
18 the Department of Highways to pave and upgrade as soon as possible the first
19 10 miles of the Fish Hook - Willow road out of Palmer.
