3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the inclusion of the  
6 Tikchik Lake area in the state  
7 park system.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Tikchik Lake area of the State of Alaska is one of the few  
10 unspoiled areas of the country abounding with attractions for tourists,  
11 sportsmen and lovers of nature; and

12 WHEREAS this area, which is bounded by the Moshagak River on the East,  
13 the Togiak River on the West, the source of the Aniak River on the North  
14 and the settlement of Manokotak on the South should not be exploited by  
15 this generation but should be preserved for the future recreational needs  
16 of the citizens of Alaska and visitors who will be coming to this state in  
17 ever increasing numbers; and

18 WHEREAS this area constitutes an ideal location for a state park - the  
19 land having already been withdrawn - which would preserve the natural beauty  
20 of the area and would provide the people of Alaska and its visitors a sanc-  
21 tuary in which to enjoy the untouched splendor of the Alaska wilderness;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the governor is respectfully requested to direct  
23 the Department of Natural Resources to investigate fully the inclusion of  
24 the Tikchik Lake area in the Alaska State Park System at the earliest pos-  
25 sible date.
