5 Relating to a study of the complete tax  
6 structure of the State of Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS it is of the utmost importance to the general welfare of the  
9 state and its citizens to have a fair and equitable tax system in Alaska;  
10 and

11 WHEREAS the implementation of a sound tax system depends upon the state  
12 having acquired a thorough knowledge of the complete tax structure; and

13 WHEREAS most of the tax information available to the state is based  
14 upon a study made five years ago; and

15 WHEREAS because of the tremendous growth and development which has  
16 taken place in Alaska since 1962, the tax information with which the state  
17 must work has become obsolete; and

18 WHEREAS ascertaining what effect taxation has upon the economic de-  
19 velopment of the state is of the utmost importance to the state;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed, with the co-  
21 operation of the Department of Revenue, to make a complete study of the tax  
22 structure of the state and to make a full report to the Fifth Legislature,  
23 Second Session, along with any recommendations, including suggested legis-  
24 lation deemed necessary, if any, as a result of the study.
