5 Relating to time.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS the Federal Uniform Time Act of 1966 requires that all states
8 uniformly go on daylight saving time for a certain portion of each year
9 beginning in 1967, unless they exempt themselves; and

10 WHEREAS the Department of Transportation, the agency responsible for
11 administration of that Act, has indicated that the Act will not be applied
12 to Alaska until 1968; and

13 WHEREAS there appears to be some uncertainty as to the value of
14 daylight saving time in Alaska; and

15 WHEREAS this uncertainty is compounded by the requirement in the Act
16 that Southeastern Alaska change to Yukon standard time from Pacific standard
17 time;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is requested to study the
19 matter and make recommendations to the Fifth Legislature, Second Session.
