5 Commending the Alaska Railroad for the out-
6 standing services it rendered to the
7 victims of the Tanana Valley disaster of
8 1967.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the Tanana Valley flood of August 14, 1967, left the residents
11 of the Fairbanks area without food or shelter and in dire need of finding
12 ways of evacuating the disaster area; and

13 WHEREAS the Alaska Railroad answered this urgent call for assistance by
14 providing to the residents of the ravaged country gratuitous transportation
15 to Anchorage and back; and

16 WHEREAS, in furnishing this transportation in its swift and timely
17 manner, the Alaska Railroad rendered an outstanding public service to the
18 people of the Fairbanks area; and

19 WHEREAS the Alaska Railroad also greatly assisted the City of Nenana by
20 transporting to it two reefer-type freezer boxcars;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska commends the
22 Alaska Railroad for the valuable public services it rendered during a time
23 of great need to the victims of the Tanana Valley flood.
