6 resentative from Alaska to the Presi-
7 dential Prayer Breakfast.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the legislature recognizes that the strength of an individual
10 community, state or nation is relative to and dependent upon spiritual
11 values; and

12 WHEREAS the founding and history of our nation was based on and inter-
13 woven with man's faith that God has a hand in the affairs of men; and

14 WHEREAS the legislature recognizes that spiritual values and faith in
15 divine guidance should have increasing emphasis in our time; and

16 WHEREAS it is good that leaders of our nation and the world meet in
17 spiritual attitude and prayer; therefore in recognition of the tradition
18 of our forefathers

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to appoint
20 Representative Jack R. Simpson to represent the Governor, the legislature,
21 and the State of Alaska at the prayer breakfast with President Lyndon B.
22 Johnson to be held in Washington, D. C. on February 1, 1968.
