5 Relating to hearings and report with  
6 regard to a state prison.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS there is no room or facilities for exercise or rehabilitation in  
9 the present state jails; and

10 WHEREAS the present overall conditions in the state jails can be and  
11 have been described as deplorable; and

12 WHEREAS these facts do harm to both the inmates and to society in  
13 general; and

14 WHEREAS the state spends a great amount of money sending convicted  
15 felons to other states for imprisonment;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to conduct hear-  
17 ings as to whether or not Alaska should have its own state prison consisting  
18 of modern facilities, and to make a full report of its findings to the Sixth  
19 Legislature, First Session.
