2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 7

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to construction of a school  
6 in Kongiganak.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the threat to life and property due to flooding and damage from  
9 ice floes in the Kwigillingok area has motivated the re-establishment of the  
10 village of Kongiganak on high ground 15 miles away; and

11 WHEREAS there is no school facility at Kongiganak for the 34 school age  
12 children, and the children are required to attend boarding schools in south-  
13 eastern Alaska; and

14 WHEREAS next year there is expected to be as many as 60 to 70 school  
15 age children in the village; and

16 WHEREAS the Bureau of Indian Affairs will not be able to construct a  
17 school in the village for the next three to five years;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct  
19 the Rural Development Agency to provide for the construction of a school  
20 facility for Kongiganak during the summer of 1968, with the intention that  
21 this facility will be used as a community center as soon as a BIA school is  
22 constructed.
