5 Relating to the employees of the
6 Alaska State Housing Authority.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the State Personnel Act (AS 39.25) applies to all state em-
9 ployees not exempted or partially exempted by the Act and requires personnel
10 administration based upon the "merit principle"; and

11 WHEREAS the Alaska State Housing Authority is a state agency and its
12 employees are state employees; and

13 WHEREAS the employees of the Alaska State Housing Authority are not
14 specifically exempted or partially exempted by statute from the State Person-
15 nel Act; and

16 WHEREAS an August 1963 memorandum from the office of the attorney
17 general to the Department of Administration confirmed the fact that the
18 benefits of the State Personnel Act apply to the employees of the Alaska
19 State Housing Authority; and

20 WHEREAS neither the commissioner of administration nor the personnel
21 board has taken action under AS 39.25.130 to extend the partially exempt
22 service to include these employees;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct
24 the Department of Administration and the Department of Commerce to comply
25 with state law and place the employees of the Alaska State Housing Authority
26 on the merit system under the State Personnel Act.
