3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the construction of an
6 electrical transmission line between
7 Cook Inlet and Fairbanks.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Alaska Power Commission has announced its support for
10 construction of an electrical transmission line between Cook Inlet and
11 Fairbanks via the "Railbelt"; and

12 WHEREAS money is currently available for use in updating the study
13 previously made; and

14 WHEREAS it is necessary to present a request for preconstruction ap-
15 propriations to the Bureau of the Budget by September, 1968, to be included
16 in the 1970 national budget; and

17 WHEREAS the need for power in Alaska, especially in the "Railbelt" area
18 is growing each day; and

19 WHEREAS the establishment of an electrical transmission line between
20 Cook Inlet and Fairbanks would do much toward supplying that need and at
21 the same time reduce the cost of electrical energy;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to endorse,
23 on behalf of the state, the concept of an electrical transmission line
24 between Cook Inlet and Fairbanks via the "Railbelt" and to encourage, promote,
25 and assist the Alaska Power Commission so that construction of the electrical
26 transmission line can be accomplished as soon as possible.
