5 Relating to a park maintenance work  
6 program for high school boys.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS many able-bodied and industrious high school boys are unable  
9 to find summer employment in the state; and

10 WHEREAS much maintenance work needs to be done in our state parks and  
11 recreation areas; and

12 WHEREAS high school students could gain valuable work experience in the  
13 outdoors and could benefit the state by helping with this maintenance work;

14 BE IT RESOLVED that the governor is respectfully requested to direct  
15 the Department of Natural Resources to initiate a pilot program in which 16  
16 through 18 year old boys are hired at the state minimum wage to work on and  
17 maintain our state parks and recreation areas during the summer months.
