5 Commending the citizens of the Greater
6 Juneau Borough.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS during the Centennial year 1967 the people of Juneau, Douglas,
9 and the rural areas of Greater Juneau Borough voluntarily taxed themselves
10 approximately a third of a million dollars, and the residents of the City of
11 Juneau contributed land of a like amount in value, as the local share of
12 constructing a new State Historical Museum; and

13 WHEREAS during the Centennial year the museum was completed and on
14 January 7, 1968 officially presented to all the people of the State of Alaska
15 as a gift from Gastineau Channel residents; and

16 WHEREAS the museum building -- one of the outstanding such structures
17 of Alaska and the entire Pacific Northwest -- resulted not only from tax
18 dollars but from hours of dedicated work and devotion on the part of the
19 Gastineau Channel Centennial Association and numerous individuals; and

20 WHEREAS the new Alaska State Museum is a project in which the entire
21 state takes great and justifiable pride;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature extends to the Gastineau Charne.
23 Centennial Association and all the citizens of the Greater Juneau area its
24 special commendation and appreciation for their efforts in the creation and
25 completion of the Alaska State Museum Building in Juneau.

26 COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to all members of the Gastineau
27 Channel Centennial Association; to the Honorable Joseph George, Mayor of the
28 City of Juneau; the Honorable Guy Russo, Mayor of the City of Douglas; and
29 to the Honorable Myrton R. Charney, Chairman of the Greater Juneau Borough.
