2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 27

5 Relating to the construction of a small
6 boat harbor at Nenana.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the community of Nenana is endowed with the potential for
9 becoming a center of hunting, fishing and sport boating activity for the
10 Nenana, Clear and Fairbanks areas; and

11 WHEREAS Nenana is located on the Tanana River at an embarkation point
12 for sportsman into the Minto Flats country and other sporting and recreation
13 areas; and

14 WHEREAS the Nenana community is making significant independent effort
15 to attract tourists, fishermen and hunters into the area as a means of
16 economic growth; and

17 WHEREAS the completion of the new Fairbanks-Nenana-Anchorage highway
18 will place Nenana on what may prove to be the most heavily traveled highway
19 route in the state; and

20 WHEREAS a small boat harbor will be of the essence in developing
21 recreation of every type for the traveler and the sportsman;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct
23 the Department of Public Works, and the Department of Natural Resources to
24 study and prepare plans for the development of a small boat harbor and
25 recreational campground at Nenana and submit these plans to the Sixth
26 Legislature, First Session.
