5 Directing the Legislative Council to
6 study the problem of log salvage and
7 recovery.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS many logs are, through one circumstance or another washed up
10 on the many beaches in this state; and

11 WHEREAS at present under existing law, it is impossible for the state
12 or a few private individuals to salvage these lost or abandoned logs; and

13 WHEREAS it would be beneficial to the entire state if utilization of
14 these many logs could become a reality; and

15 WHEREAS salvage operations cannot now be accomplished due to conflicts
16 created by the rights in upland owners and those of the owners of the logs;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to make a
18 thorough and complete study of log salvage and recovery and report its
19 findings and recommendations, if any, to the Sixth Legislature, First Session
