3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to an Air Age Education Program

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS there are 15,756 students enrolled in grades nine - 12 in Alaska
8 in the current school year with about one-half of the total being 16 years
9 of age or over; and

10 WHEREAS an estimated 10 per cent of these - approximately 750 - could
11 be reached through an Air Age Education Program; and

12 WHEREAS Alaska has more than 2000 general aviation aircraft, 400
13 charted airfields, more float planes than anyplace else in the world, and
14 fewer highways outside municipalities than any other state; and

15 WHEREAS these facts illustrate the great investment which Alaska has
16 in the air age, and demonstrates the need for our young people to be educat-
17 ed in the various aspects of the air age;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct
19 the Department of Education to study the feasibility of an Air Age Education
20 Program in cooperation with the Federal Aviation Agency and the Alaska Air-
21 men's Association, and to report its findings and recommendations to the
22 Sixth Legislature, First Session.
