5 Relating to a study of insurance rates

6 in Alaska by the Legislative Council.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the high insurance rates for workmen's compensation and auto-  
9 mobile insurance in Alaska have a detrimental and far-reaching effect on the  
10 economy of the state; and

11 WHEREAS there has been no over-all study of insurance rates with regard  
12 to workmen's compensation and automobile insurance in the state to determine  
13 whether the present rates are justified;

14 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to make a  
15 comprehensive study of these two aspects of insurance with regard to rates  
16 in Alaska and compare these rates with those charged in other states where  
17 comparable services are provided and submit a report of its findings to the  
18 Sixth Legislature, First Session.
