5 Relating to a study of insurance rates

6 in Alaska by the Department of Commerce.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS excessive high insurance rates for workmen's compensation, fire
9 and automobile insurance in Alaska have a detrimental and far-reaching
10 effect on the economy of the state; and

11 WHEREAS several years have elapsed since there has been a study of in-
12 surance rates and losses with regard to workmen's compensation, fire and
13 automobile insurance in the state to determine whether the present rates
14 comply with the provisions of AS 21.39.031 in that they are not excessive,
15 inadequate or unfairly discriminatory;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Commerce is directed to make a
17 comprehensive study of these three aspects of insurance with regard to rates
18 in Alaska and compare these rates with those charged in other states where
19 comparable services are provided and submit a report of its findings to the
20 Sixth Legislature, First Session.
