5 Relating to a study of insurance rates

6 in Alaska by the Department of Commerce.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS excessively high insurance rates for workmen's compensation,  
9 fire and automobile insurance in Alaska have a detrimental and far-reaching  
10 effect on the economy of the state; and

11 WHEREAS several years have elapsed since there has been a study of in-  
12 surance rates and losses with regard to workmen's compensation, malpractice,  
13 errors and omissions, fire and automobile insurance in the state to determine  
14 whether the present rates comply with the provisions of AS 21.39.031  
15 in that they are not excessive, inadequate or unfairly discriminatory;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Commerce is directed to make a  
17 comprehensive study of these five aspects of insurance with regard to  
18 rates in Alaska and compare these rates with those charged in other states  
19 where comparable services are provided and submit a report of its findings  
20 to the Sixth Legislature, First Session.
