2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 7

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to social security payments to
6 the senior citizens of Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS federal civil service employees in Alaska are allowed a 25 per
9 cent differential in pay to compensate for the high living costs in Alaska;
10 and

11 WHEREAS senior Alaskan citizens receiving social security payments are
12 not allowed a differential in their payments; and

13 WHEREAS the average overall cost of living in Alaska is more than 25
14 per cent higher than the cost of living in the contiguous 48 states; and

15 WHEREAS the high cost of living in Alaska compels many senior Alaskan
16 citizens to leave Alaska and move to other states where the living costs are
17 less expensive and more in conformity with their social security income; and

18 WHEREAS past and current inflationary and rising costs of living make
19 it increasingly difficult for senior citizens, residing in Alaska and depend-
20 ing upon fixed incomes or pensions, to purchase the necessities of living;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Congress of the United States is requested to
22 enact legislation which would permit the 25 per cent differential currently
23 used in the federal civil service pay scale to be incorporated into the
24 benefit payment scale of social security for Alaskan citizens.
