2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 10
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the immediate enforce-
6 ment of the new 12-mile limit.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS Congress has already seen the need to extend the limits of
9 the nation's territorial waters to 12 miles; and

10 WHEREAS foreign exploitation will continue until enforcement is given
11 to the full 12-mile limit; and

12 WHEREAS the immediate enforcement of the 12-mile limit is of great
13 economic importance not only to the state but to the Nation as a whole; and

14 WHEREAS less than full enforcement of the limit could lead to more
15 confusion and conflict with foreign nations;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of State, in cooperation with the
17 Department of the Interior and the United States Coast Guard and other
18 interested federal agencies take steps to have the new 12-mile limit
19 enforced immediately to its full extent.

21 Johnson, President of the United States; the Honorable Dean Rusk, Secretary
22 of State; the Honorable Stewart L. Udall, Secretary of the Interior; Admiral
23 Willard J. Smith, Commandant, U.S. Coast Guard; and to the Honorable E.L.
24 Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest Gruening, U.S. Senators, and the Honorable
25 Howard W. Pollock, U.S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in
26 Congress.
