5 Relating to the holding of raffles  
6 and lotteries in on-base high schools.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the raising of money by high school students is a vital part of  
9 carrying out many of the high school's programs; and

10 WHEREAS raffles and lotteries have always been used by high schools  
11 throughout the nation as a means of raising money for worthy purposes; and

12 WHEREAS the money raised from high school raffles and lotteries goes  
13 to good causes connected with educational pursuits; and

14 WHEREAS high school raffles and lotteries are fairly and properly  
15 administered and controlled by school officials; and

16 WHEREAS the State of Alaska has never maintained a policy against the  
17 holding of high school raffles and lotteries for worthy purposes:

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of the Air Force is respectfully  
19 requested to allow the holding of raffles and lotteries in the on-base high  
20 schools under its command in Alaska.

22 of the Department of the Air Force; Colonel Louis W. Rohr, Commander USAF;  
23 and to the Honorable E.L. Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest Gruening, U.S.

25 of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
