2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 23

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the stationing of a  
6 Coast Guard vessel in the Alaska  
7 Peninsula-Aleutian Area.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the commercial fishing in the Alaska Peninsula-Aleutian area  
10 has become a year around activity with hundreds of boats in operation; and

11 WHEREAS fishing in this area is often carried out under adverse con-  
12 ditions with ever present hazards to life and property; and

13 WHEREAS there have been numerous incidents where fishing boats in the  
14 area have been in distress and assisted, if at all, only by other fishing  
15 boats; and

16 WHEREAS the rendering of aid by other fishing boats which lack the  
17 proper rescue equipment oftentimes results in the further endangering of  
18 life and property; and

19 WHEREAS this area also needs a Coast Guard vessel to police foreign  
20 fishing activities which have openly violated the law; and

21 WHEREAS the nearest Coast Guard vessel which can give rescue aid is  
22 approximately 500 miles away from this area;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Honorable Lyndon B. Johnson, President of the  
24 United States, direct the Department of the Treasury to station a Coast Guard  
25 vessel in the Alaska Peninsula-Aleutian area.
